Kids Astronomy

Monday – Thursday, 9:00pm

Embark on a journey through the cosmos and learn to navigate your way around the night sky. Explore the constellations, bright stars and deep space objects that are visible in the summer night sky with the aid of a telescope.

Nightly Stargazing (weather permitting)

Nightly, 8:00pm, and 9:30pm

The sky is truly the limit at Primland. You are invited to take a tour of the universe in our state of the art observatory dome using the latest technology for stargazing and astrophotography. On clear nights, the roof of the dome slides back to reveal the night sky above. Using a combination of traditional naked eye and advanced telescope viewing, you will explore the beautiful winter sky and extraordinary deep space objects visible from our dark location away from city lights. Blankets are provided for the duration of the tour. Additionally, we recommend bringing a warm coat, gloves, and something to keep your head warm. Cost for this activity is \$35/person, no charge for children under 10. Stargazing tours operate nightly (weather permitting) and are subject to capacity limits. Consider planning your initial reservation for your first night at Primland. If it is cloudy, the tour will be cancelled and you will not be charged. Guests staying for additional nights are able to transfer their reservation to another night provided there is availability. SPORTS AND FITNESS

Junior Naturalist Program

Hike the Pinnacles Trail and gain invaluable skills for navigation and exploration. Children ages 5-11 will learn about Primland's rich topography, as well as how to properly handle binoculars, a field compass and a map on their journey. A field bag and booklet will be provided to complete activities along the trail. Upon completion children receive a Primland Junior Naturalist Patch. See Guest Services.

Archery/Air Rifle

Saturday, March 11 and 25, 10:00am

Learn the proper techniques for handling archery equipment, then practice shooting at bull's-eye and 3-D targets. Air guns include Daisy, Benjamin and Gamo with spinner, bulls-eye, rolling and balloon style targets.

Nature Walk

Hike along the Pinnacle Overlook Trail with one of our expert guides, and discover the abundance of flora and fauna along the way. Awaken your senses with the different fragrances and identify various plant species with this invigorating walk through our forest.

Orienteering

Basics of Disc Golf

Tomahawk Throwing

Try your hand at Tomahawk Throwing, a tradition common to Native American tribes as well as scouts and frontiersmen. Accuracy, strength, distance and rotation of the axe are challenging factors in the quest to throw and land the single-handed axe into the wood target.

Upland Hunts

Upland hunting is one of Primland's longest standing traditions. An Orvis-endorsed wingshooting lodge since 1990, Primland's highly trained and attentive staff will guide you across the majestic Blue Ridge landscape in pursuit of the land's hard flushing, flighty birds. You can also challenge yourself to pheasant hunting, as well as targeting bobwhite quail and chukar for additional shooting opportunities. Three-hour Upland Guided hunts are available September through April.
